**ORDER**

**PER G.S. PANNU, VP :**

This appeal by the assessee for the assessment year 2010-11 is directed against the order of learned CIT(A)-7, New Delhi dated 8<sup>th</sup> July, 2019.

The learned counsel for the assessee, vide email dated 12<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 has requested for withdrawal of the appeal filed by the assessee and stated that the assessee has opted to settle the dispute relating to the tax arrears for the assessment year under consideration under the Vivad Se Vishwas Scheme, 2020.
