**ORDER**

**PER G.S. PANNU, VP :**

This appeal by the assessee for the assessment year 2010-11 is directed against the order of learned CIT(A)-12, New Delhi, dated 26.02.2019.

2. None appeared on behalf of the assessee at the time of virtual hearing. The learned counsel for the assessee, vide its letter dated 01.03.2021 received by speed post, has requested for withdrawal of the appeal filed by him and
