ORDER

PER G.S. PANNU, VP :

This appeal by the assessee for the assessment year 2013-14 is directed against the order of learned DRP-2, New Delhi, dated 27.03.2017.

2. The learned counsel for the assessee, vide its letter dated 20.04.2021 received by e-mail, has requested for withdrawal of the appeal filed by him
